OUR WORK

Let's look at some of our most memorable recipients whose lives have been touched forever and at those who have touched our lives forever in return.

The Children of Glodeanu

Starvation, illness, and extreme poverty have touched the daily of over 50 children and their families living in the small village of Glodeanu, Romania. Though our extended network of working with the local church community, we had come to meet Father Marian Tudor. A kind soul and shepherd who has taken under his wings the children of the sick and unemployed parents who did not have the means to provide for the basic needs of their children, sometimes enduring multiple days passing without the hope of a meal.

Through God's grace and help, Father Marian Tudor took on the mission to make a difference and bring some light in their vulnerable lives. Driven by compassion, he put his heart into restoring an old village hall and turning it into a day care center where children can eat one hot meal per day, receive daily help with school work, and have a place to play and socialize with others.





Spreading joy, restoring strength and sharing smiles with the children of Giurgiu

For the Children of Giurgiu, where over 50 kind and loving children who suffer from severe physical and cognitive disabilities, we have raised over \$10,000 to purchase a physical rehabilitation equipment.

The physical therapy machine being used on a daily basis has improved the lives of the children significantly and their parents have renewed their hope and faith in their children's future.

Our support has brought back the precious smiles on their parent's faces and in the lives of their children, who now look forward to strengthening their body, mind and spirit.

The Children of Marcus Orphanage

Mother Serafima family has grown with each year that passes by. She is strict, caring, kind and careful about each of her children, the orphaned girls who she has taken on as her own, offering them a home, an education, and most importantly faith and hope for their future.

A new home for the children at the "Social Settlement of Saint Onuphrius"

One of our newest collaborations taken on in 2015 is with Farther Visarion at the Social Settlement of Saint Onuphrius, at the Floresti Monastery in Romania. In the spring of 2015 had raised over \$10,000 to help the organization purchase a van for their facility.

We have supported the construction of the settlement with 48,200\$ during the year of 2015.

Five family-style houses for the protection of children facing hardship have been constructed on a land donated by the Protection of the Holy Virgin Monastery in the immediate vicinity of the Floresti Monastery. This Social Settlement offers a harmonious family climate, proper care, education and emotional support for children who are temporarily or permanently separated from their parents and optimum conditions for their physical, intellectual, moral and spiritual development.









OUR FINANCIALS

From 2010 to 2015 we have raised and sent over to Romania an estimated \$320,200 that helped thousands of needy children with financial and in-kind donations.

Each project has been carefully screened and the beneficiaries needs assessed and identified so every dollar invested has provided the highest level of impact for each of our successfully handpicked local projects and individual beneficiaries that have demonstrated the highest need of financial and in-kind donations.

Our 100% promise means that every dollar donated by the public goes to the field. In the past five years, our money went to nutrition, housing, education, medical care developmental and physical therapy projects in across 10 major projects serving thousands of individual beneficiaries.

We kept Saint Paraskeva Orthodox Charity running efficiently with 100% of our profits going to our projects. And all the while our volunteer's board members supported us along the way.
